DANIEL BECKER TO RECEIVE THE 2016 MORRIS LUBITSKY MEMORIAL AWARD



Congregation Etz Chayim is proud to announce Daniel Becker as this year's recipient of the coveted Morris Lubitsky Memorial Award for 2016.

Danny was born in Columbus, Ohio to Sara and Albert Becker of blessed memory. He is the older brother of Chuck (Martha) and Roberta.

Danny attended the Ohio State University and graduated from the University of Wisconsin (Milwaukee) in 1976 with a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.
