



FROM THE RABBI

Omer—Joy Turned Tragic



An omer is a unit of volume. When we commonly refer to the omer, we are speaking of a sacrifice that was brought in the Beit Hamikdash. An omer of barley, the first grain to ripen, was offered beginning on the second day of Passover. We count the days beginning from the second day of Passover for seven complete weeks, culminating in the holiday of Shavuot.

Passover of course celebrates our release from Egyptian slavery. Seven weeks after our redemption we came to Mt. Sinai and heard Hashem's voice as the Torah was given. The period between these two events should be joyous. The fact that the new crop is now becoming useable only adds to that celebration. Unfortunately however, circumstances did not stay that way.

Rabbi Akiva was a great sage that lived during the period of Rome. 24,000 of his students died during the period of the omer. In later years the crusades and other tragedies took place at this time as well. Now the period of the omer is observed as a time of limited mourning, when we do not have weddings or do other joyous things. These customs are observed by most for 33 days, as this was the length of the plague in the time of Rabbi Akiva.

During the omer this year, as we remember the past, we hope and pray for a time when we can no longer mourn over plagues and crusades, but rather celebrate new crops and special sacrifices.

Our grant for \$87,000.00 was finished and received by the state on March 20. We should hear their decision by the end of April or early May. Whether we receive the grant or not, one of the benefits of writing the grant is that we are more cognizant of areas of security that need to be addressed. We will continue to work on ensuring that Etz Chayim is as safe as possible for each of our members.



