And in the end, it will help each of us enjoy the mitzvah of remembering our loved ones.

Our dear friend Ruthie passed away this past month leaving a void for so many of us. Whether she was in the kitchen, in the third pew of the synagogue or just being around, she will be missed. Stories and memories abound involving Ruthie. Few people in our community missed the opportunity to interact with her.

Preparations for Bar and Bat Mitzvahs, Kishka dinners, Shabbat family meals, fireside chats, shul social events, and on and on, Ruthie was present and involved.

One need only look at the synagogue to see the recognition that was awarded to Ruthie. Our synagogue kitchen is dedicated to her and her beloved Danny. She was Sisterhood "Woman of the Year", and several years later she was named "Woman of the Years". She was the recipient of the Morris Lubitsky Memorial Award, many community awards and the list goes on and on. But Ruthie never wanted the accolades. She just did what was needed to be done in her own quiet way. Tables had to be impeccably set for dinners. Corners of the table cloths had to have the point in line with the table leg. Forks always went on the left side, knives and spoons on the right side and glasses had to be in the correct position. There was not a "T" left uncrossed or an "I" left undotted. When Ruthie took on a task, it was followed through with perfection. So many kitchen volunteers learned the proper kashruth and the details of preparing and plating foods with a beautiful presentation. She always taught everyone who worked with her that the way food was prepared and served was a reflection of the shul.

Ruthie set a standard for each of us to follow. She loved people. She treated her family as friends and her friends as family. She lived life to its fullest.

It is only fitting that we remember Ruthie for so many reasons. She truly was not only the matriarch of Etz Chayim, but also of the Jewish community. We thank you Ruthie for being able to experience the beauty of your life. Your gift to each of us was wrapped beautifully – in a smile, with a hug and a kiss, and with that special piece of advice – please know that you have touched each of us.

Rest well dear friend. Each of us is richer for having had you in our lives.


That evening at 7:00 p.m. will be a Celebration of the Arts at Hope Lutheran Church on Secor Road in Ottawa Hills.
