FROM THE RABBI

Which Is The Real Adar?



With this year being a leap year, we are blessed with a calendar containing two months called Adar. According to halacha, which is the “real” Adar and which is the added month?



If we go back to the days before the fixed calendar, it was not known in advance when a leap year would occur. Therefore, every year, commemorations would be done in the first Adar. Now, however, we know ahead of time when leap years are. What should we do?

It seems to be the consensus that the first Adar is the real one. Therefore, the most common custom observed is to, for example, commemorate Adar yahrtzeits in the first Adar. The exception, however, is Purim. The sages decreed that we should always celebrate Purim in the second Adar. This way the redemption of Purim has a closer connection to the redemption of Passover.

Adar also comes with a command to be happy. We should be able to observe this mitzvah in both months. Our wish is that Hashem give us only tangible goodness and joy for both the first and second Adars.

Frequently we have spoken to our ongoing security concern at Etz Chayim. Certainly, that continues to be a concern on the part of the Board of Trustees. In order for you to know what is being done, I would like to delineate some of our efforts. Among the items being considered are:

- New audio and visual equipment for our parking lot entrance
- Better lighting in our parking lot
- Better security for our chapel
- Making our doors at both the eastern and western ends of the building more secure
- Putting concrete posts in front of the doors to prevent a car from breaking into the building

In addition, we held an Active Shooter Training session on Sunday, January 13th, for our membership and at no expense to the shul.

None of our plans come without cost. In fact, it is a rather large expenditure. In a future letter, I will be enumerating the costs. It is also my intention to ask our congregation to help defray these costs by making a donation strictly for the purpose of synagogue security. 

Once again, Etz Chayim announces the **Dorothy Phillips Camp Scholarship Fund**.

This fund was made possible by a generous bequest of Dorothy Phillips, widow of Philip Phillips. The bequest allows that the money be used for programs to benefit youth. We encourage participation by our children in Jewish summer camp programs.

The earnings of the Dorothy Phillips Scholarship fund will be used for summer overnight camp programs for Etz Chayim children. The following criteria were established by the trustees to be used to determine an approved camp:

Observance of Shabbat
Observance of Kashrut
Jewish Programming
Not affiliated with another Synagogue movement

This would include, but not be limited to:

NCSY Camps
Young Judea Camps
JCC Camps
Approved Summer Israel Educational Experiences

Eligible students will be:

Children of synagogue members enrolled in Etz Chayim Sunday School or who have been confirmed at Etz Chayim.

The earnings of the fund will be distributed each year among the number of approved applicants. Applications are available in the synagogue office.

The deadline for accepting applications for the summer of 2019 is March 31, 2019.

GEORGE AND EVE DAVIDSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

George and Eve Davidson, long time members of Congregation Etz Chayim, have created a generous endowment for the youth of the synagogue. The fund shall be used annually to send an Etz Chayim student, or students, from families who are unable financially and economically to do so themselves, for a summer or a year in Israel to study and to learn about Judaism and the Jewish people.

Included, for consideration, will be shorter trips which otherwise meet the designated guidelines.


