### INFORMATION REGARDING THE UPCOMING HIGH HOLIDAYS



The Religious Committee has been hard at work considering our options for holding High Holiday services.

Of course the country is still in the midst of the corona virus pandemic. We continue to follow the guidelines set by the Orthodox Union and if they mandate that services cannot be held, we will abide by that decision.

With the hopes that services will take place, the synagogue has hired Joseph Gold as the chazzan for Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur. He has been coming to Toledo for many years to help lead services and is well known for his excellent davening and reading the Torah.

In addition, we are excited to announce that Rabbi Yehoshua Mizrachi will be our guest rabbi for the holidays. He is a very dynamic and engaging person and will add much enthusiasm to the services.

We are considering many options to make the synagogue environment a safe one for everyone. We have prepared the sanctuary by marking the pews with tape so people will be seated at an acceptable social distance. This means we will have to limit the number of men and women attending. We will be taking reservations for each day of Rosh Hashana, Kol Nidre and Yom Kippur. Masks will be required to be worn. Sanitizers will be available and surfaces and books will be cleaned prior to and following services.

All plans will be finalized by the middle of August and a letter will be mailed out to the membership noting all the details.

If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to call me at the synagogue office. With the limited office hours, you can always leave a message on the answering machine and I will return your call.

Let's stay safe, healthy, and positive. Hopefully this New Year of 5781 will be the start of good things to come to Congregation Etz Chayim.

### Sisterhood Recipe of the Month

#### **Eggplant Dip** From Gina Black



- 1 eggplant
- 1 or 2 Tbsp. mayonnaise
- 3 cloves of minced garlic (fresh is better)
- Salt and pepper (to taste)



Make three slits into the eggplant with a knife.  
Bake the eggplant for 45 min. at 400 degrees on a sprayed baking sheet.  
Check on the eggplant occasionally while cooking. When you can smash it down with a fork, it is done.  
Let the eggplant cool on a cutting board.  
Peel and finely chop the eggplant.  
In a bowl, mix the eggplant with the mayonnaise, garlic, salt and pepper.




