FROM THE PRESIDENT

There are moments that stand out as ones where it feels so right to be a Jew. Some of those moments are big ones, others are small. Even in these most difficult times to be Jewish, those moments still come. One was at a wedding we recently attended. There was so much joy and love that it was easy to set aside everything that is going on beyond those walls. For those several hours that world was one filled with joy and freedom to celebrate a wedding and celebrate Judaism. And certainly, I felt a sense of the Jewish continuum and the freedom to be a Jew.

Another recent moment was when Nancy and I visited the Indiana Historical Society where there was an interactive exhibit of Eva Kor, who was a Holocaust survivor of Auschwitz. She and her sister were twins who endured experiments done by Joseph Mengele. Eva became a Holocaust activist and educator. Initially, she carried a lot of anger that kept her down. Her emphasis turned ultimately into one about empowerment and forgiveness. She said that when she learned to forgive, she no longer felt like a victim. I've heard it said that knowledge is power. So too, it can be said that faith is power. As the late Rabbi Sacks said, "Jews survived all the defeats, expulsions, persecutions, and pogroms, the centuries in which they were regarded as a pariah people, even the Holocaust itself, because they never gave up the faith that one day they would be free to live as Jews without fear."

The Eva Kor exhibit will be at the Indiana Historical Society until August.




